0012875	Cor-Ten steel CAMPUS CORTEN bench (pine wood)
0012855	Cor-Ten steel CAMPUS CORTEN PIANA (without backrest) bench (exotic wood)
0012885	Cor-Ten steel CAMPUS CORTEN PIANA (without backrest) bench (pine wood)

All versions listed above are supplied fully assembled.

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Additional equipment needed:



- **power drill with $\varnothing 8$ mm bit**
- **no. 4 chemical or mechanical anchors M8**
- **suitable wrench for tightening the anchors**
- **no. 4 washers M8**

1. Make sure that the ground is level and solid enough (concrete, asphalt, stone or porphyry are all suitable materials).
2. Drill four holes in the ground, concentric with the holes on the baseplates (Fig. 1). Level the bench and fix it to the ground with four chemical or mechanical anchors (Fig. 2) and washers.
